GRANT BACKGROUND

The QUEST initiative provides access to no cost career services and training opportunities for job seekers whose employment has been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Services that are provided include:



CAREER EXPLORATION

Career coaching, resume/ interview preparation, and more.



TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Possible financial assistance with occupational training.



EARN WHILE YOU LEARN OPPORTUNITIES

Receive apprenticeship support, on-the-job training, and more.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

- Workers temporarily or permanently laid off as a result of COVID-19
- Dislocated Workers (separation of employment at no fault of your own)
- Unemployed workers which include long and short-term (within 2 months or more of unemployment), underemployed and/or needing to work multiple jobs, and individuals with limited or no work history
- Formerly and currently incarcerated individuals (within 12 months of release)
- Self-employed individuals who are unemployed or significantly underemployed as a result of COVID-19
